





One is to a horse race meeting and the other to Matlock Bath, Derbyshire to visit Sir Richard Arkwright's Masson Mill which is a water-powered cotton spinning mill situated on the west bank of the River Derwent. This mill, which was built in 1783, forms part of the Derwent Valley Mills and is a World Heritage Site. We will be able to have a guided tour for an hour and there is a restaurant which seats 150 people, various cafes and a village outlet with 60 shops. For those wishing to further their interest in the Arkwright Mills there is the first of his mills (Cromford Mill) which is a UNESCO Site and it is only a short walk from Masson Mill and this would be a nice walk for those not interested in the 60 shops!

At the moment we are waiting for Illingworth Moor Methodist Church to give us the dates of the 'Holiday at Home' which they run in the summer and which makes it so we cannot use the Church building for two days. The Committee think it would be a good idea to have one of our trips when we have this enforced closure of classes. Full details will be available shortly.
