3. Minutes of the last meeting held on Thursday, 16th January 2014:	Approved and signed as a correct record by the Chair.
4. Matters arising from the Minutes:	There were no matters arising from the Minutes.
5. Correspondence: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Insurance: Apparently information had gone out about Insurance matters and we had been missed so luckily the Chair of High Five gave us the information. • The Secretary pointed out the document 'Your Community', which is from the Ovenden & Mixenden Initiative, had advertised our Committee Meeting which clearly they had taken from the LA Group website. 	The Treasurer had paid the required amount for the group to be insured for the next year The Secretary had made contact about this and they will be pleased to advertise any event we are holding in future.
6. Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer reported that the group had £4,558.71 in the bank at the end of February. As of 6 th March 2014 that amount had reduced to £4,486.10. The Treasurer had been going over the accounts looking at outgoings every month in Tutor Fees and Rent. The cost per quarter is £1,365. The Treasurer recommended that the charge for classes with Tutors be increased to £3.	Fully discussed and agreed unanimously that for the Art, Tai Chi and Keep Fit the cost should increase to £3 from the 1 st April 2014. This information to be given by word of mouth at the groups affected. The Secretary to prepare new adverts showing increased price & website.
7. Membership: The Membership Secretary reported there had been no new members as we were close to the end of the year. As the Membership Secretary is away at the start of April she requested all money and Renewal Forms be kept together in the envelope that she provided and kept for her return.	The Membership Secretary was thanked for her report.
8. Short Report covering attendance/issues in the current week: Art Class – There had been 9, 8, 9 and 9 + 1 new person the current week. Classes at Illingworth Moor M.C. on 6 th and 13 th March due to Fire Station being unavailable. Crafty Club – Normally between 12 and 14. Using Morrisons Training Room for two weeks due to Fire Station being unavailable. Keep Fit – 12/14/12/12 Kurling – February attendance had been 19/15/16/18 – this week 14. Tai Chi - There was no report but we had word that there had been 10 that day.	Thanks were expressed to those delivering activity group reports.
9. Forthcoming Events: Games Afternoon, Tuesday, 11th March 2014 – 2 – 4 pm: Well established pattern now. FP and IP will do refreshments. Ceilidh: Zig Zag Band booked for Saturday, 10 th May 2014 to start at 7 pm. The Secretary was asked to contact each of the groups set up by the Neighbourhood Scheme inviting them to attend. Tickets were given to reps from each group and posters are available. The Chair said that the band will do two sets of playing and the supper would be served between sessions. Line Dancing: The Secretary had contact SOFA who run a line dancing group and had been given the name of Helen O'Hara although the Chair had had information that Helen wasn't teaching now. Another name 'Crazy Legs' was suggested and Graham or Annette. The only venue in the area for line dancing would be Illingworth Moor Methodist Church and the only day the room is available is on a Tuesday but not on the first Tuesday of every month. Christmas Meal at The Moorlands: The Chair had enquired at The Moorlands about the use of the Marquee. The minimum number was 100 people (max. 200). If we wanted it at a weekend we could join with two or three smaller parties. She had looked into having an Elvis Impersonator at a cost of £250 for 2 x 45 minute sessions.	Secretary had done small flyers and notices were out and about advertising the event. The Treasurer to organise the purchase of the necessary pies and peas giving consideration to vegetarians. The Membership Secretary asked that forms and money be returned to her in the envelope provided. It was suggested that 2 or 3 Taster sessions are tried in the Autumn. After discussion it was agreed the Chair should book The Loft at The Moorlands, which holds up to 80 people, for Wednesday, 3 rd December to arrive at 5 pm to eat at 5.30 pm.
